As of December 31st, 2026, the County will no longer be supporting the Warning Sirens in Palmer Township and surrounding communities.

Please be aware that at this time you will need to get notification of severe weather conditions and events from your phone, TV or a weather radio.

Below are a couple of options that help to receive notices!!

Hyper-Reach: Hyper-Reach is used exclusively by Sherburne County for its residents and visitors and can be triggered by the county Dispatch Center or through a series of predefined prompts such as location and type of warning i.e. tornado, flash flood, etc. Hyper-Reach is a mass emergency notification system that is FREE and built specifically for public safety that delivers rapid notifications during hazardous and urgent situations through a comb You will only receive weather-related warnings through Hyper-Reach if you sign up for them.
